
The tool

Developed by SODA following prioritisation and consultation process with stakeholders of DA in Surrey

NIHR Applied Research Collaboration Kent, Surrey and Sussex

Purpose: Sharing and Visualization of aggregate and anonymised data of DA incidents /referrals from multiagencies across Surrey.

Impact: Data driven decision making - better allocation and use of resources; intelligent planning of DA interventions and services; improve multi-agency responses for better outcomes.

Aim

Further engage with partners and stakeholders of DA to explore acceptability, how it could be used in practice, what could promote or inhibit adoption, implementation, and sustained use.

Status of the project

Funding application to a recent ARC KSS Priorities for Care call was unsuccessful.

Have received: support and interest from stakeholders locally and at national level (via SC theme); favourable ethical opinion from University of Surrey REC is in place.

Next: Internal resources will be used to conduct this work to inform refinement of the tool; development of an implementation toolkit and Grant application to the next NIHR Social care call for a wider implementation study.
