

The Involvement of People with Lived Experience of Adult Social Care or Social Work & Carers in the Programme

The programme aims to involve people with lived experience of social work and social care both across the programme and in projects and support the development of our understanding of good practice for involvement in adult social care research.

ARC West Midlands Activity:

- Involve people with lived experience in prioritising what research should happen in the programme
- Facilitate a group of people with lived experience of social work or social care to advise on involvement in the programme and across projects
- Facilitate discussion with other national adult social care research bodies about public involvement
- Conduct research which evaluates public involvement across programme projects and builds on knowledge about lived experience involvement in adult social care research
